



The Parent Driving Zone - How to Use this DVD

The scale of the problems we now face on America's roads demand new cutting edge ideas and solutions. *The Parent Driving Zone* DVD contains the knowledge and information both parents and new drivers need, to start turning this needless tragedy around.

There are over 50 chapters and 18 sub-chapters in this DVD. This information is designed to help parents with children of ALL ages, from newborn to 18 years of age and beyond.

The Parent Driving Zone DVD is divided into 3 Parts:

Part 1 and Part 2:

We encourage ALL parents and guardians to watch both parts. These sections last approximately 55 minutes. There is a break in the middle for convenience and discussion. This section has been created to run for less time than a one hour TV show on purpose. My hope being that any parent would be happy to spend at least that much time, to gain important traffic safety information to help them and their children be safer.

Part 3:

Parents: Please watch the Sections that apply to the age of your child.

Section 1 – For parents with newborns up to children in booster seats.

Section 2 – For parents with children aged 8 through 14, which is before they start any permit or supervised driving.

Section 3 – For parents with children just beginning the learning to drive process and/or starting Driver Education. This would include Permit Driving, having

supervised driving time with a parent and certainly before they can legally drive on their own.

Section 4 – For parents with a child who has obtained a FULL license and can now drive on their own. This can include children in their first year of driving who are subjected to Graduated Driving Law restrictions.

I highly recommend parents and children watch Sections of Part 3 together.
